



- An accelerating force: imagine what Africa would look like if leaders from all sectors used their skills, resources and networks to drive social change! The potential is boundless.




Ashoka is convening these minds and ideas to build an "everyone a changemaker" Africa.

Ashoka started in Africa in the early nineties to support systems-changing social innovators who are addressing the most critical social and environmental problems on the continent. Ashoka Fellows drive systems-change on the continent

91 % are still pursuing the idea for which they were electing a Fellow (sustainability)

- 88 % have seen their idea replicated by other groups or organizations
 - % have achieved legislative change

- 43 mn people in Africa have directly received Fellows' programs / services in 2020
 - 89 % report that the Ashoka stipend helped them focus full-time on their idea
